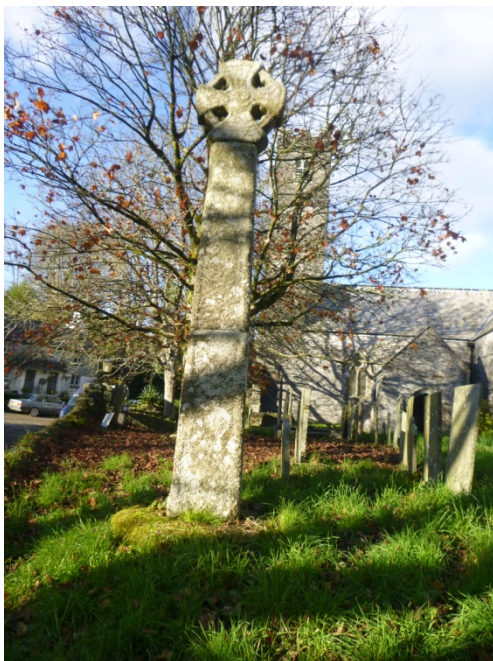


Cornwall Archaeological Society Area Representative Monument of the Month

MEDIEVAL CROSS IN QUETHIOCK CHURCHYARD

The Medieval cross in St Hugh's churchyard at Quethiock is one of the tallest crosses in Cornwall.

The cross head and base were found buried in the churchyard in 1881 by workmen. The Reverend William Wilmot found the shaft in use as two gateposts. The fragments of the cross were cemented together and the cross was re-erected on 25th July 1881 on the spot it was found which was considered to be close to its original site.

The cross is a Scheduled Ancient Monument
