MEDIEVAL WAYSIDE CROSS IN ST IVO'S CHURCHYARD, ST IVE

A plain latin cross stands against the south boundary wall in St Ive churchyard. In 1932 it was discovered in use as a gatepost, 155m south of its present position, from where it was moved to the south-east side of the churchyard. The cross measures 1.65m in height, width of head 0.533m, width of shaft 0.305m and thickness of shaft 0.203m. The monument was included in the Schedule on 16/2/1996.
